We are excited to let you know that we have had many applications for "Guests" for the Maternity Home, and our team is doing a great job processing those applications! I've also realized that what I relay to you, our Birthline team of supporters, about those applications and Guests is sensitive material which we're not at liberty to make public. Bummer! We want to share the stories in detail of these brave women who have applied and who have been offered the chance to live in the home. If I could tell those stories I would relay details of women pressured to have abortions, women living in cars, abandoned by partners, abandoned by family and parents, fighting battles with drugs and alcohol, fighting to keep jobs, women going to college, women with no education, women navigating the legal system, consistently seeing their probation officers, women working to reestablish relations with their children, women from our community, women from Denver, women from further into our region – all in need and curious to see if this is the place where they will find help and get a fresh start. Each story different, each life precious (mother and child), each one tended to by our stalwart Maternity Home Steering Team of skilled and passionate staff and volunteers. And we are making sure that each applicant gets to tell

their story and be heard, and get a square and well-rounded look from our team for assessment, and each applicant either accepted for the Home or connected with better and more suitable resources. Keep praying for this hard and important work, and for all these women and babies who come our way!

# PERSONAL STORY - MELONIE UPDATE AND INTERIM ASSISTANT DIRECTOR, PATRICIA BRENNAN

Birthline has been in a bit of a limbo-state over the past month, but we are now on a good path forward thanks to some Board-creativity and one Patricia Brennan. Our Assistant Director Melonie Fusilier had hip replacement surgery on February 7th, and unfortunately it was complicated by a mild stroke a few days later. She spent 2 extra weeks in a rehabilitation hospital and is now home, but she still has lingering effects. Since her return is undefined we have asked Patricia
